



HOW TO APPLY LEATHER BALM

MATERIALS NEEDED

- tmbr Leather Balm
- Soft lint-free cloths
- Leather cleaner (if needed)
- Soft brush (optional)

STEP 1: CLEAN THE LEATHER

1. Remove dust and dirt from the leather surface.
2. Use a suitable leather cleaner if necessary and allow the leather to dry completely.

STEP 2: TEST ON A SMALL AREA

3. Apply a small amount of balm to an inconspicuous area.
4. Allow it to absorb and check for any color change before proceeding.

STEP 3: APPLY THE LEATHER BALM

5. Using a clean cloth, apply a small amount of balm to the leather.
6. Work the balm into the surface using circular motions.
7. Apply a thin, even coat across the entire item.

STEP 4: ALLOW THE BALM TO ABSORB

8. Let the balm absorb into the leather for 10 to 30 minutes.



STEP 5: BUFF THE SURFACE

9. Use a clean, dry cloth to buff the leather.
10. Continue until the desired sheen is achieved.

STEP 6: INSPECT AND REAPPLY IF NEEDED

11. Check for dry areas that may require additional treatment.
12. Apply a second light coat if necessary.

TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS

- Avoid over-applying the balm, as excess product can leave a greasy finish.
- Condition leather periodically to maintain suppleness.
- Store leather items in a cool, dry place.
- Always follow the manufacturer instructions for the balm being used.
- Test new products before full application.
